Innovation Point Network LLP operates <https://www.innovationpointnetwork.com> (herein after referred to as “website”). This document talks about our policies regarding the use, disclosure and collection of Personal Information we receive from the users of our website.

We use your Personal Information only for providing you information and/ or updates with matters of interest and relevance to you and for improving the website. By using our website/marketing promotions, you agree to the collection and use of information that we engage in, in accordance with this policy.

Collection of Information & It’s Use

While using our website, we may ask you to provide us certain personally identifiable information that may in future be used to identify and/ or contact you via means of email/ phone/ mail. Personally identifiable/ Personal Information may be inclusive of, but not limited to your name, email address or physical location.

Log Data

Like several other website operators, we collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our website (hereinafter referred to as “Log Data”). The Log Data may include information such as your computer’s Internet Protocol (‘IP’) address/ es, browser type, browser version, pages of the website that you visited, the date and time of your visit, the time spent on those respective pages and allied statistics.

In addition, we may use third party services such as Google Analytics that collect, monitor and analyze this information, to provide us with visitor trends and analysis.

Communications

We may use your Personal Information to contact you with eNewsletters/ Whitepapers, Marketing or Promotional material/ s and other information that may be associated with your professional/ work interests. Most information we collect about you comes from our direct interactions with you. When you register for an event we may collect information (online or offline) in relation to the event organization, and during an event, such as participation in sessions and survey results. We combine the personal information we collect to develop aggregate analysis and business intelligence for conducting our business and for marketing purposes. You can choose to receive information by email, telephone or postal mail about our products and services, or sign-up for subscriptions. When visiting our websites or using our services we may provide you with personalized information. You can always opt-out from receiving personalized communication by sending an e-mail to wecare@innovationpointnetwork.com. Where we reference that we use your personal information in connection with a request, order,

transaction or agreement (or preparing for the same), or to provide you with services that you requested (such as a website), we do this because it is necessary for the performance of an agreement with you. Where we reference that we use your personal information in relation to marketing, improvement or development of our products or services, for reasons of safety and security, or regulatory requirements other than in connection with your agreement or request, we do this on the basis of our or a third party's legitimate interests, or with your consent. When we collect and use your personal information subject to the GDPR/CASL/CCPA/PDP Privacy Legislation this may have consequences for your rights

Your Rights

You can request to access, update, delete or correct your personal information. You also have the right to object to direct marketing. You can access the request process on wecare@innovationpointnetwork.com.

You may have additional rights pursuant to your local law applicable to the processing. For example, if the processing of your personal information is subject to the GDPR/CASL/CCPA/PDP, and your personal information is processed based on legitimate interests, you have the right to object to the processing on grounds relating to your specific situation. Under GDPR/CASL/CCPA/PDP you may also have the right to request to have your personal information deleted or restricted and ask for portability of your personal information.

Cookies

Cookies are files with small amounts of data, which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and stored on your computer's hard drive.

Like many other websites, we use 'cookies' to collect information. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our website.

Security

The security & privacy of your Personal Information is of paramount importance to us but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, can be considered 100% secure. While we constantly strive to use commercially acceptable and available means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot possibly guarantee it's absolute security.
